

Anzac Biscuits



Creative Writing Ideas

- 1 Write a funny script for two or three people about making Anzac biscuits, based on your own experiences. Include anything that went well as well as anything that didn't go quite so well. Act out the script for an audience.
- 2 The mystery of the disappearing Anzac biscuits. The principal has called a special assembly; his Anzac biscuits are missing, and he wants to know what has happened to them. Perhaps you may know something about it?
- 3 Describe the day in the life of an Anzac biscuit. You could choose to write in the third person about the biscuit or in the first person, as though you are the character of the biscuit telling the story.
- 4 Write a children's adventure story about an incredibly brave Anzac biscuit who overcomes all kinds of obstacles to emerge a hero.
- 5 Write down the conversation or argument that two Anzac biscuits might have over who is better – the soft, chewy one who has cranberry added, or the golden, crispy one with one side dipped in chocolate?
- 6 Write an Anzac biscuit poem. Will it be a free verse poem, an acrostic poem, a haiku, a rhyming couplet or something different?
- 7 Write and produce an advertisement to promote your new Anzac biscuit product. Consider the ingredients, price, flavour, texture, marketing and packaging. What makes your biscuit better than all of the others? After completing your written content, decide how you advertise your product – will you design an advertisement to display in shop windows? Will you record a radio advertisement, complete with a catchy jingle? Will you film a television advertisement?
- 8 Write an informative text about the Anzac biscuit. Possible topic headings could include the history of the Anzac biscuit, the ongoing popularity of the Anzac biscuit and your experience making Anzac biscuits.
- 9 Write a love letter to the Anzac biscuit. Describe your favourite qualities of the Anzac biscuit, happy memories you've had involving the biscuit and why you like (or love!) the biscuit. Keep an eye on your grammar and make sure you use either singular or plural to describe the Anzac biscuit throughout your letter.
- 10 How many words can you make from the letters that spell 'Anzac biscuits'. Can you find more than 30? More than 50? More than 100?
